2.2. One (1) exception may be made to this general policy:

2.2.1. Certain specialized courses designed to meet the continuing education needs of public and private school personnel.

2.3. Courses and classes not qualifying for academic credit may be assigned C.E.U. value.

2.4. Except as may be specifically so allocated or approved by the West Virginia Higher Education Policy Commission, no state appropriated funds may be utilized for the direct and identifiable costs of noncredit courses and classes. It is expected that course and class fees and/or contractor gift funds will cover all identifiable direct cost of noncredit courses or classes.
