

## Commuter Status Verification Form

Glennville State University requires all full-time students to reside on campus facilities unless granted an exemption. All students seeking an exemption to this policy must apply and submit all supporting documentation for their request to be considered.

A guardian/grandparent/sibling who is over 21 years old that lives within a 50-mile driving radius from the University according to Google Maps.

If a student wishes to apply for the residing with an immediate family member exemption, they must complete this form in its entirety and have it notarized by a Notary Public. This form must be resubmitted for approval. This form does not guarantee that off-campus status will be granted.

Students seeking an exemption (for the current academic year) must complete the application in full and submit all supporting documentation no later than the Friday of the first week of classes of the fall semester.

Any student who knowingly misleads or provides false information for the purpose of obtaining a housing exemption is subject to university discipline.
